This podcast show was designed to provide individuals of colour with a platform to express themselves and be acknowledged. It delved into various topics ranging from childhood experiences to parenting to mental health. Before and following the recording, I meticulously organised and maintained the location. I monitored audio levels of microphones ensuring optimal quality, and making necessary adjustments in the sound suite during the recording process. Additionally, I greeted guests, arranged the green room, and ensured the well-being of all individuals involved on the day of the recording.
